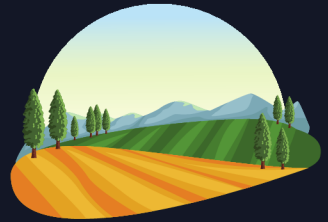
Growth & Flourish

How Does Our **Eco-Farm** Benefit The Poor?



60% of all farm profits permanently dedicated to widows, orphans & vulnerable families.



11,078 kg of milk distributed directly to vulnerable families and targets children at risk of stunting which in Syria has reached 16.1%.



Employment for displaced families as many workers are IDPs (Internally Displaced Person.)



Reduced water cost in an area where prices reach £10 per tanker.

One-time investment → Continuous, long term support for the poor

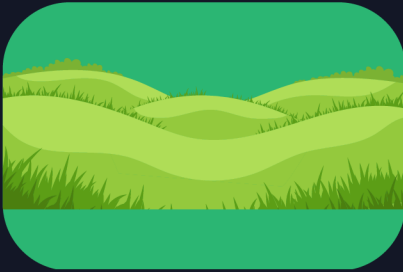

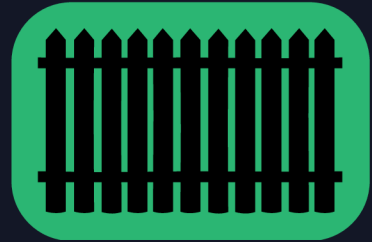

What the Barn Changes (Monthly Impact):

- More milk produced: an extra £360 each month
- Less feed wasted: saving £95 each month
- Water sold locally: at least £120 each month

Result: the farm moves from needing donations to covering its own running costs — becoming self-sustaining and able to support widows and orphans long-term.

Solar well & water economy:

- Solar well powers the farm: £60,000 investment
- Water produced daily: 40,000 litres
- Cows use: ~10,500 litres/day
- Surplus water: ~29,500 litres/day
- Water sold locally: at least £120 each month

Result: Free solar water helps keep the farm running without ongoing donations — the farm becomes self-sustaining and able to support widows and orphans long-term.



- Quarterly reports covering herd health, milk production, and finances.
- Monthly photo and video updates to verify progress and asset condition.
- On-site branding, with the barn clearly marked as a Revive project.
